

Mid Year H&S 2009/10 Update

Thank you to all Home and School members and volunteers. We have been hard at work providing many programs and services for Moorestown students. Some highlights are: \$14,400 to subsidize field trips, Student Directories for each of our 6 schools, \$700 to subsidize student book purchases during the Book Fairs, turkey dinners for 127 Moorestown families, mittens, hats and scarves from mitten trees for MEND families, Staff Appreciation breakfasts, lunches, and snacks, and Transition Day Events, and Ice Cream Socials. The District wide assembly –Ball in the House- was enjoyed by several of the elementary schools. (More shows later in the year.) Each year we provide money for cultural programs and school improvements. Not all schools have designated their funds yet and some are saving for a larger item.
