A need for additional space is one of the primary drivers for this referendum.



Our elementary populations are approaching or above totals from nearly a decade ago and many PK-3 classes have reached the maximum number of students allowed per board policy. As a result, numerous students have had to be reassigned to a school other than his/her home school. Additionally, the number of students in basic skills, special education, specialized programming and advanced classes have increased over the years, impacting how space is utilized.

How do we use space in our schools?

Our use of space has shifted in recent years, from the traditional classroom housing up to 25 students to varying configurations designed to best meet student needs, including:
