Sixth Graders at WAMS

Housing grades 6-8 together at WAMS will enable us to provide more stability and a consistent, true middle school environment. The three grade model allows students more time to grow in their role as middle schoolers and offers more time to develop programs, promote teacher/student relationships and provide individualized instruction.

As with all transitions, there are likely many questions, along with some feelings of uncertainty. If the Referendum passes, the District will undergo a collaborative planning process to work out the many specific details involved. **However, here is what you can anticipate the new WAMS configuration to look like:**

- Sixth grade will have its own wing of WAMS, so the 6th grade will stay together in one primary space but will move around during their Enrichment periods.
- Sixth graders would be provided with opportunities to use specialized facilities, such as science labs, industrial tech shop, art rooms, video production space, and the new Innovation Lab.
- Sixth graders will have access to a more robust World Language experience.
- WAMS also focuses on deeper problem-solving, critical thinking, listening and presentation skills and creativity, all things needed for today's global learners.
- WAMS provides broader guidance and support for issues related to developing adolescents.
