WHAT

A Bond Referendum is planned for Tuesday, December 10, 2019. The Referendum addresses three important areas – **Space, Security and Sustainability** – and will be broken into two questions. The first question incorporates the most urgent and impactful needs of the district, as well as maximizes state aid, while the second question includes items that are important but are not as time-critical and are eligible for a limited amount of debt service aid from the state.

Under the Debt Service Aid program, the District will receive up to 40% aid reimbursement on all eligible costs.
