Dear Parent/Guardian:

The end of the school year is quickly approaching, and we are preparing for the mathematics placement process. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the criteria used to place your child in the appropriate mathematics course for the 2023-2024 school year. Your child's placement for next year will be determined using the following criteria:

- Spring 2023 Math MAP (to be administered the week of May 1st)
- Math Proficiency Test (to be administered June 1st)
- The average of your child's Marking Period grades in Mathematics
- The average of your child's Mathematics Chapter Tests

The data from the above criteria will be totaled and translated to a total placement score. Placement is determined by a cutoff score for each course level. Your child will be placed in either an on-level mathematics course (PreAlgebra), an enriched mathematics course (CP Algebra I), or an accelerated mathematics course (Honors Algebra I).

A letter notifying you of your child's mathematics placement will be posted to Genesis by the end of June. Another email will be sent when the letter is ready to be viewed on Genesis. Students who do not move up a level via our placement process may choose to test over the summer to attempt to place in a higher level. More information is on the district math website, www.mtps.com/academics/mathematics under Summer Testing Opportunities. There are two testing dates available this summer (July 19 and August 16), and students may test on one date only. This information, along with the registration information, will be shared in the final placement letters in June.
