## Web Access to IEPs

Click on the '**STUDENT DATA**' tab in the Genesis portal and then on the '**Summary'** sub-tab. Select your child in the '**SELECT STUDENT**' drop-down (If you have more than one child, you will need to do this for each child).

To the right of your child's picture, you will see a button that says **'IEP Direct Document Portal'**. Click that button and a pop-up will say "You are now opening an external website" - click '**OK**'.
